

A Combined Checklist of the Birds of Cabañas San Isidro & Guango Lodge

Compiled by Mitch Lysinger

The following list includes all species known to occur at Cabañas San Isidro, Guango Lodge and their surrounding areas within a 5 km radius, such as the early stretches of the Guacamayos Ridge trail.

The abundance categories assigned to each species (common, rare, etc.) is an attempt to try and reflect a species' true abundance in the area and not necessarily the frequency with which they are seen. As an example, Chestnut-crowned Antpitta is listed as common - which it is - but it is mostly heard and very hard to get a look at.

A more detailed checklists with natural history information is provided at the lodges. An exhaustive and complete account of Cabañas San Isidro's birds is under preparation in *The Natural History of the Birds of Cabañas San Isidro and Surrounding Areas*.

Birds with an asterisk (*) are represented by voice on the commercially available tape, *The Birds of Cabañas San Isidro* that can be purchased through the American Birding Association or at San Isidro Lodge.

Bird names in **bold** have been found on Cabañas San Isidro and/or Guango Lodge. The taxonomic order, nomenclature and abundance categories used here follow Ridgely, R.S. and Greenfield, P.J. 2001, *The Birds of Ecuador*. Note that many birds such as Anhinga or Crane Hawk are out of their usual ranges, so the abundances used in the book have been altered accordingly and honed to be useful when birding the San Isidro Lodge and Guango Lodge areas.

Highland Tinamou - San Isidro; rare resident.

Plain-breasted Hawk - San Isidro & Guango; uncommon resident.

Semicollared Hawk - San Isidro; rare resident.

Barred Hawk - San Isidro; fairly common resident.

Solitary Eagle - San Isidro; rare (resident?).

Roadside Hawk * - San Isidro & Guango; common resident.

Broad-winged Hawk * - San Isidro & Guango; fairly common migrant.

White-throated Hawk - Rare (migrant?) at San Isidro; more common at Guango.

Swainson's Hawk - San Isidro; very rare transient.

Black-and-white Hawk-Eagle - San Isidro; very rare visitor.

Black-and-chestnut Eagle * - San Isidro & Guango; fairly common resident.

Collared Forest-Falcon * - San Isidro; fairly common resident.

American Kestrel - San Isidro; rare visitor.

Merlin - San Isidro; very rare transient.

Bat Falcon - San Isidro; rare visitor.

Orange-breasted Falcon - San Isidro; rare visitor.

Peregrine Falcon - San Isidro; very rare transient.

Andean Guan * - San Isidro & Guango; uncommon resident.

Wattled Guan * - San Isidro; uncommon resident.

Sickle-winged Guan * - San Isidro; fairly common resident.

Rufous-breasted Wood-Quail - San Isidro; very rare visitor.

Spotted Sandpiper - San Isidro & Guango; fairly common migrant.

Upland Sandpiper - San Isidro; rare transient.

Southern Lapwing - San Isidro area; locally common resident.

Andean Gull - San Isidro; very rare visitor.

Band-tailed Pigeon - San Isidro; common resident.

White-throated Quail-Dove * - San Isidro; fairly common resident.

Greater Ani - Guango; accidental.

Smooth-billed Ani * - San Isidro; fairly common seasonally.

Barn Owl - San Isidro; uncommon resident.

White-throated Screech-Owl - San Isidro & Guango; uncommon resident.

Andean Pygmy-Owl - San Isidro area; very rare (resident?).

'Mystery Owl' [Strix (Ciccaba) sp.] - San Isidro; extremely local, but readily seen resident.

Mottled Owl - San Isidro; uncommon resident.

Rufous-banded Owl * - San Isidro; fairly common resident.

Short-eared Owl - San Isidro; very rare visitor.

Oilbird - San Isidro; uncommon to rare (resident?).

Andean Potoo * - San Isidro & Guango; uncommon to rare (resident?).

Rufous-bellied Nighthawk * - San Isidro; common resident.

Band-winged Nightjar * - San Isidro; uncommon resident.

Swallow-tailed Nightjar - San Isidro area; locally uncommon.

Lyre-tailed Nightjar - San Isidro area; locally uncommon.

White-collared Swift * - San Isidro & Guango; common resident.

Chestnut-collared Swift * - San Isidro; fairly common resident.

Spot-fronted Swift - San Isidro; rare resident.

White-chested Swift - San Isidro; uncommon resident.

Short-tailed Swift - San Isidro area; rare visitor.

Gray-rumped Swift - San Isidro area; rare visitor.

White-tipped Swift - San Isidro area; uncommon resident.

Tawny-bellied Hermit * - San Isidro; fairly common resident.

White-tipped Sicklebill - San Isidro; uncommon to rare resident.

Lazuline Sabrewing - San Isidro; very rare visitor.

Brown Violetear - San Isidro & Guango; rare visitor.

GreenVioletear * - San Isidro; rare visitor.

Sparkling Violetear * - San Isidro & Guango; seasonally common.

Speckled Hummingbird * - Abundant resident at San Isidro; less common at Guango.

Rufous-vented Whitetip - San Isidro; rare to uncommon visitor.

Violet-fronted Brilliant - San Isidro; uncommon to rare visitor.

Fawn-breasted Brilliant * - San Isidro; very common resident.

White-tailed Hillstar - San Isidro; seasonally uncommon at the feeders.

Shining Sunbeam - Guango feeders; uncommon.

Mountain Velvetbreast - Uncommon visitor to San Isidro; very common resident at Guango.

Great Sapphirewing - Guango feeders; seasonally common.

Bronzy Inca * - San Isidro; very common.

Collared Inca * - San Isidro & Guango; very common.

Buff-winged Starfrontlet - Very rare visitor to San Isidro; seasonally common at Guango.

Sword-billed Hummingbird - Guango; very common.

Buff-tailed Coronet - Rare visitor to San Isidro; uncommon resident at Guango.

Chestnut-breasted Coronet * - Very common resident at San Isidro; uncommon resident at Guango;.

Tourmaline Sunangel - Rare visitor to San Isidro; abundant at Guango.

Glowing Puffleg - Guango; uncommon resident.

Golden-breasted Puffleg - Very rare visitor to San Isidro; uncommon resident at Guango.

Emerald-bellied Puffleg - San Isidro; uncommon to rare resident.

Greenish Puffleg - San Isidro; uncommon resident.

Booted Racket-tail - San Isidro; rare (resident?).

Purple-backed Thornbill - Guango; seasonally fairly common.

Tyrrian Metaltail - Rare at San Isidro; abundant at Guango.

Mountain Avocetbill - Guango; uncommon resident.

Long-tailed Sylph * - San Isidro & Guango; abundant resident.

Wedge-billed Hummingbird - San Isidro; uncommon to rare resident.

White-bellied Woodstar - Rare to uncommon at San Isidro, common resident at Guango.

Gorgeted Woodstar - Uncommon (visitor?) to San Isidro; fairly common resident at Guango.

Crested Quetzal * - San Isidro & Guango; fairly common resident.

Golden-headed Quetzal * - San Isidro; common resident.

Masked Trogon * - San Isidro & Guango; common resident.

Highland Motmot * - San Isidro; fairly common resident.

White-faced Nunbird * - San Isidro; rare resident.

Emerald (Andean) Toucanet * - San Isidro; fairly common to common resident.

Gray-breasted Mountain-Toucan - Guango; uncommon resident.

Black-billed Mountain-Toucan * - San Isidro; uncommon to fairly common resident.

Black-mandibled Toucan - San Isidro area; very rare wanderer.

Crimson-mantled Woodpecker * - San Isidro & Guango; fairly common to common resident.

Golden-olive Woodpecker - San Isidro; uncommon to rare (resident?).

Lineated Woodpecker - San Isidro; rare wanderer.

Smoky-brown Woodpecker - San Isidro; uncommon to fairly common resident.

Yellow-vented Woodpecker * - San Isidro; uncommon to fairly common resident.

Bar-bellied Woodpecker - Rare (visitor?) in the San Isidro area; fairly common resident at Guango.

Powerful Woodpecker * - San Isidro & Guango; uncommon to fairly common resident.

Crimson-bellied Woodpecker - San Isidro; rare (wanderer?).

Azara's Spinetail * - San Isidro & Guango; very common resident.

Rufous Spinetail * - San Isidro & Guango; uncommon to fairly common resident.

Ash-browed Spinetail - San Isidro; rare to uncommon resident.

Streaked Tuftedcheek * - San Isidro & Guango; fairly common resident.

Pearled Treerunner * - San Isidro & Guango; common resident.

Spotted Barbtail * - San Isidro; fairly common resident.

Rusty-winged Barbtail * - San Isidro; uncommon to fairly common resident.

Lineated Foliage-gleaner * - San Isidro; fairly common.

Tawny-rumped Tyrannulet - Guango; uncommon resident.

White-crested Elaenia - San Isidro & Guango; fairly common but eruptive.

White-banded Tyrannulet - Guango; very common resident.

White-tailed Tyrannulet * - San Isidro; common resident.

Sulphur-bellied Tyrannulet * - San Isidro; common resident.

Torrent Tyrannulet * - San Isidro & Guango; fairly common resident.

Bluish Flower-piercer * - San Isidro; very common resident.

Golden-eyed Flower-piercer - San Isidro; rare (visitor?)

Glossy Flower-piercer - Very rare visitor to San Isidro; uncommon (resident?) at Guango.

White-sided Flower-piercer * - San Isidro & Guango; fairly common resident.

Fawn-breasted Tanager * - San Isidro & Guango; fairly common to common resident.

Blue-naped Chlorophonia - San Isidro; eruptive and can be common.

Chestnut-breasted Chlorophonia * - San Isidro; uncommon to fairly common resident.

Thick-billed Euphonia - San Isidro; very rare visitor.

Golden-rumped Euphonia * - San Isidro; fairly common resident.

Orange-bellied Euphonia * - San Isidro; common resident.

Bronze-green Euphonia - San Isidro; rare to uncommon visitor.

Orange-eared Tanager - San Isidro; locally rare to uncommon resident.

Saffron-crowned Tanager * - Common to very common resident at San Isidro; uncommon at Guango.

Flame-faced Tanager * - San Isidro; common resident.

Golden-naped Tanager * - San Isidro; fairly common to common resident.

Beryl-spangled Tanager * - San Isidro; common to very common resident.

Blue-and-black Tanager - San Isidro & Guango; fairly common to common resident.

Black-capped Tanager * - San Isidro; common resident.

Blue-necked Tanager - San Isidro; uncommon to fairly common resident.

Paradise Tanager - Guango; irregular, but has been fairly common for short periods.

Golden-crowned Tanager - San Isidro area; rare visitor.

Scarlet-bellied Mountain-Tanager - Uncommon resident at San Isidro; fairly common resident at Guango.

Lacrimose Mountain-Tanager * - San Isidro & Guango; fairly common to common resident.

Blue-winged Mountain-Tanager * - San Isidro; common to very common resident.

Hooded Mountain-Tanager * - San Isidro & Guango; common resident.

Buff-breasted Mountain-Tanager - San Isidro & Guango; uncommon to fairly common resident.

Grass-green Tanager * - San Isidro; fairly common resident.

Rufous-crested Tanager - San Isidro; uncommon to fairly common resident.

Blue-gray Tanager * - San Isidro; common resident.

Palm Tanager - San Isidro; very rare visitor.

Summer Tanager * - San Isidro; uncommon to fairly common migrant.

Red-hooded Tanager * - San Isidro & Guango; uncommon resident.

White-lined Tanager - San Isidro; very rare visitor.

Common Bush-Tanager * - San Isidro; very common resident.

Yellow-whiskered Bush-Tanager * - San Isidro; uncommon to fairly common resident.

Gray-hooded Bush-Tanager* - Rare at San Isidro; fairly common resident at Guango.

Black-capped Hemispingus * - Uncommon resident at San Isidro; common resident at Guango.

Superciliaried Hemispingus - San Isidro; very rare visitor.

Oleaginous Hemispingus * - San Isidro; fairly common resident.

Black-eared Hemispingus * - San Isidro & Guango; common resident.

Black-headed Hemispingus - Guango; rare to uncommon resident.
White-capped Tanager * - San Isidro; uncommon to fairly common (resident?), but erratic.
Plushcap - San Isidro & Guango; uncommon to fairly common resident.
Masked Saltator - San Isidro; very rare (resident?).
Rose-breasted Grosbeak - San Isidro; rare transient.
Black-and-white Seedeater - San Isidro; rare to uncommon (migrant?).
Chestnut-bellied Seedeater - San Isidro; rare to uncommon visitor.
Slaty Finch - San Isidro; rare to uncommon (resident?), but eruptive.
Pale-naped Brush-Finch - Guango; fairly common to common resident.
Slaty Brush-Finch - Rare in the San Isidro area; common resident at Guango.
White-rimmed Brush-Finch * - San Isidro; locally uncommon resident.
Chestnut-capped Brush-Finch * - San Isidro; fairly common resident.
Stripe-headed Brush-Finch * - San Isidro & Guango; uncommon resident.
Yellow-browed Sparrow - San Isidro area; uncommon to fairly common resident.
Rufous-collared Sparrow * - San Isidro & Guango; abundant resident.
Northern Mountain-Cacique * - San Isidro & Guango; common resident.
Subtropical Cacique * - San Isidro; common resident.
Yellow-billed Cacique * - San Isidro; uncommon resident.

Hypothetical species

Birds that have been reported but that either need further confirmation due to the species' genuine rarity in the area, lack of details and/or that the observer felt uncertain about its identity.

Gray-bellied Hawk - One report of an adult near San Isidro; mostly a lowland bird.

Black Hawk-Eagle - Two reports over San Isidro; found mostly at lower elevations.

Crested Eagle - One report near the Rio Aliso of an immature bird.

Apomado Falcon - One report at San Isidro; found mostly at higher elevations.

Military Macaw - One report from the property of a flying pair.

White-chinned Swift - Some recent reports near the cabins; a very difficult field identification.

Wire-crested Thorn-tail - Two reports along the Log Trail; mostly at lower elevations.

Buff-fronted Foliage-gleaner - One report of unknown origin; mostly at lower elevations.

Plumbeous-crowned Tyrannulet - There are only two reports of this scarce tyrannulet.

Slaty-capped Flycatcher - One report of three birds seen and heard along the Cock-of-the-Rock Trail.

Black-throated Tody-Tyrant - Two sight reports of unknown race.

White-throated Spadebill - A few unconfirmed sight records.

Black-collared Jay - Two unconfirmed reports from the Guacamayos Ridge area.

Gray-mantled Wren - One report only; mostly at lower elevations.

Rusty Flower-piercer - One report only; further confirmation desired.

Ashy-throated Bush-Tanager - A few unconfirmed sightings; more details desired.

Lower Stretches

The following species are only known from the lower stretches (about 3 kilometers or more) down the Guacamayos Ridge Trail. This area was only recently made easily accessible due to the construction of a well maintained rock trail that, at its furthest point, reaches a new oil pipeline - the "Pipeline Trail" - about 4 kilometers down.

The forest and birds to be found at the "Pipeline Trail" change dramatically as one drops in elevation. San Isidro has decided not to include them in the main body of the list since they occur mainly in the upper tropical zones and do not fall within the scope of what this list has traditionally covered. Nevertheless, we have included them here - even though this is an area that most do not have the time (or energy!) to visit - since it is accessible by foot (from an area that is covered by this list).

By including these species in this separate section, it is Cabañas San Isidro hope that observers will at least have an idea of what additional species have been seen here. Since this lower part of the trail has only been open for a short time, and only a few birders have made it down this far, there is still much exploration yet to be done.

Plumbeous Kite - One sighting from the lower end of the Guacamayos Ridge Trail.

Plumbeous Pigeon - Fairly common by voice.

Black-streaked Puffbird - Seen and tape-recorded not far from the pipeline.

White-streaked Antvireo - A couple of sightings from the Pipeline Trail

Rufous-rumped Antwren - Seen once in a flock along the Pipeline Trail.

White-backed Fire-eye - One sighting from the lower end of the Guacamayos Ridge Trail.

Golden-faced Tyrannulet - Fairly common by voice..

Scaled Fruiteater - One sighting from the lower end of the Guacamayos Ridge Trail.

Chestnut-breasted Wren - Two records from the lower end of the Guacamayos Ridge Trail.

Vermilion Tanager - A few sightings from the lower end of the Pipeline Trail.

Yellow-throated Bush-Tanager - A few sightings.

Long-tailed Weasel (*Mustela frenata*) - Seen most frequently crossing the roads.

Tayra (*Eira barbara*) - One of the most frequently seen of the larger mammals.

Oncilla (*Felis tigrina*) - Several recent sightings of a small cat that is most likely this species.

Jaguarundi (*F. yagouaroundi*) - A few recent sightings.

Puma (*Panthera onca*) - Has been seen recently in the forest below the cabins with cubs.

Mountain Tapir (*Tapirus pinchaque*) - Tracks readily seen at the far end of the property - some recent sightings.

Pudu sp. (*Pudu mephistophiles* ?) - Has been seen a few times recently.

Red-tailed Squirrel (*Sciurus granatensis*) - The most commonly seen mammal.

Spectacled Bear (*Tremarctos ornatus*) - Resident throughout the reserve - many recent sightings.

Porcupine sp. (*Coendou* sp.) - One seen right next to the dining room. Species undetermined.

Agouti sp. (*Dasyprocta* sp.) - Fairly common around the lodge. Species undetermined.
